By the Telegraph Act, 1868, the Postmaster-General was empowered to acquire the telegraphs then existing in the United Kingdom, in order that they might be vested in the Post-office. By a further Act, passed in 1869, the exclusive right of conveying public telegraphic messages was conferred on the Postmaster-General, and a monopoly created in favour of the Post-office in regard to such messages, similar to that enjoyed by it in favour of letters. The Act of 1868 fixed the rate at 1s. for...
